# 3 Tips for Caring Everyday

#### **Adjusting to Change** Changing Schools

Anxiety is closely connected to excitement. It is excitement with an added ingredient of fear. As your child adjusts to a new school or new class, help them find things to focus on and talk about that are exciting but don't involve fear. Also try these tips:

- ▶ Take a sneak peak—set up a time to visit school and meet teachers prior to school beginning.
- ► Talk about school by focusing on the positives—"Tell me two fun things that happened today."
- ▶ **Set them up for success**—get up early that morning, have things ready and travel plans discussed ahead of time—anything to avoid unexpected bumps.

We don't learn everything in school—we learn most of the important things in life just through living. Help reframe change as a normal part of life.



- 6:30-7:45PM—snacks & childcare provided


# **Calling All DELVE Volunteers!**
